1 OVERVIEW





Purpose:	This document describes the procedure on how to perform a clean installation of the E-Sys application.
Requirements:	<p>In order to execute the procedure, the following requirements must be met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Your computer needs to be equipped with a 32-bit or 64-bit version of Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 8.1 or Windows 10;- Your Windows account needs to have administrative privileges;- Windows UAC is disabled on your computer;- Windows Firewall is disabled on your computer;- Windows Defender is disabled on your computer;- 3rd-party firewalls or anti-virus solutions are disabled;- 7-zip is installed on your computer;- You need an E-Sys installer package;- You need an E-Sys Launcher Premium installer package;- You need a PSDzData full or lite dataset.




2 WARNINGS




	It is strongly recommended to perform the procedure on a clean, updated installation of Windows, not on your “daily drive” installation of Windows. This will prevent other software from interfering with or possibly breaking coding operations.
	<p>If E-Sys is already installed, it is mandatory to remove the application via the “Programs and Features” control panel applet as well as removing the E-Sys installation folder (Default: C:\EC-Apps\ESG\E-Sys) and data folder (Default: C:\Data) before proceeding with the procedure. Failing to do so will corrupt your E-Sys installation.</p> <p>Refer to §5 ROLLBACK (BACK-OUT).</p>
	<p>The versions of the software used to create this procedure are as follows: Windows: Windows 10 Enterprise LTSC (64-bit) E-Sys: v3.27.1 E-Sys Launcher Premium: 2.52 PSDzData: v3.57.4.003 Lite</p> <p>Although differing versions will likely have the same installation procedure, you may encounter differences, hence your mileage may vary when using this procedure.</p>
	E-Sys is only compatible with F-chassis cars. For E-chassis cars, use NSCExpert instead.
	Do not, under any circumstances, merge a newly extracted psdzdata folder with an already existing psdzdata folder. Always ensure the old data is deleted first! Failing to do so will corrupt the dataset.
	Always launch E-Sys through the E-Sys Launcher Premium application.
	I am not responsible for any damage that might occur on your computer system and/or your BMW vehicle when executing the installation procedure. You do so at your own risk.

1	<p>Navigate to the folder where your PSDzData full or lite dataset is located, right-click on the (first) file, expand “7-Zip” and choose “Extract Here”.</p> <p>Example: Psdzdata_3_57_4_003_Lite.rar</p>	 <p>Fig. 3.2.01</p>
2	<p>Wait for the extraction process to finish and open the extracted “psdzdata” folder.</p> <p>Verify that an empty “dist” folder is present in all chassis folders:</p> <p>psdzdata\mainseries\F001\F001_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\F010\F010_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\F020\F020_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\F025\F025_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\F056\F056_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\I001\I001_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\K001\K001_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\KE01\KE01_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\RR01\RR01_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist psdzdata\mainseries\S15A\S15A_xx_xx_xxx\odx\dist</p> <p>Otherwise be sure to create them.</p>	 <p>Fig. 3.2.02</p>

6	Paste the extracted “ psdzdata ” folder in the “ C:\Data ” folder by right-clicking in the Data folder and choosing “ Paste ”.	 <p>Fig. 3.2.06</p>
7	Wait for the copy/paste process to finish. This concludes the installation of the PSDzData for E-Sys.	 <p>Fig. 3.2.07</p>

1	Click on the “...” button.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.01</p>
2	Select the E-Sys data folder “C:\Data” and press “OK” to proceed.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.02</p>
3	<p>Verify that the “Path” field contains the E-Sys data folder “C:\Data”.</p> <p>Enter a token PIN in the “PIN” and “Confirm” field and press “Generate Token” to continue.</p> <p>Remember or note down the token PIN.</p> <p>Example token PIN: 1234</p>	 <p>Fig. 3.4.03</p>
4	<p>A pop-up will appear indicating that the token has been successfully created.</p> <p>Press “OK” to proceed.</p>	 <p>Fig. 3.4.04</p>
5	<p>In the “Car Series” dropdown menu, choose your car’s F-chassis designation.</p> <p>Example: F22 (2-series coupe) = F022 F30 (3-series sedan) = F030 F20 (1-series hatch) = F020</p> <p>WARNING: The E-Sys Launcher Premium application limits changes to the “Car Series” field to every few days. Make sure you enter the correct F-chassis designator or you will not be able to code your car using E-Sys!</p>	 <p>Fig. 3.4.05</p>

6	Click “Launch Now!” to start proceed.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.06</p>
7	The E-Sys Launcher Premium will automatically detect the E-Sys installation folder for you.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.07</p>
8	Again ensure that you have chosen the correct F-chassis designator in the “Car Series” field and press “OK” to proceed.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.08</p>
9	After a brief while you should see the E-Sys splash screen.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.09</p>
10	When the warning message pops-up, untick the “Show this message always.” and press “OK” to proceed.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.10</p>

12	Verify that the “Data” field is set to “C:\Data” in the “Program” tab.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.12</p>
13	Navigate to the “EST” tab and click on the “...” button.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.13</p>
14	Navigate to the E-Sys data folder “C:\Data”, select the “FreeToken.est” file you generated in step 3 and press “Open” to proceed.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.14</p>
15	Verify that the “EST” field is set to “C:\Data\FreeToken.est”.	 <p>Fig. 3.4.15</p>



16	<p>Navigate to the “Options” tab and untick the following options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Update VCM after TAL execution; - Update MSM after TAL execution. <p>Press “OK” to proceed.</p> <p>This concludes the configuration of the E-Sys application as well as the E-Sys Launcher Premium application.</p> <p>Please keep in mind that you must always launch E-Sys through the E-Sys Launcher Premium shortcut on your desktop. 2	Enter “ appwiz.cpl ” in the “ Open ” field and press “ OK ” to proceed.	 <p>Fig. 5.02</p>

3	Select “ E-Sys Launcher Premium ” and choose “ Uninstall ”.	 <p>Fig. 5.03</p>
4	Press “ Yes ” to proceed.	 <p>Fig. 5.04</p>
5	Wait for the uninstall process to finish. Once the process has finished, the progress window will disappear without confirmation.	 <p>Fig. 5.05</p>
6	Select “ E-Sys 3.27.1 (build 44813) ” and choose “ Uninstall ”.	 <p>Fig. 5.06</p>
7	Press “ Yes ” to proceed.	 <p>Fig. 5.07</p>
8	Wait for the uninstall process to finish.	 <p>Fig. 5.08</p>

12	Right-click on the selected folder(s) and choose “Delete” in the context menu. When asked confirm, choose “Yes”.	 <p>Fig. 5.12</p>
13	Wait for Windows to remove the folder(s). This concludes the removal of the E-Sys application, E-Sys Launcher Premium application and the associated PSDzData dataset.	 <p>Fig. 5.13</p>
